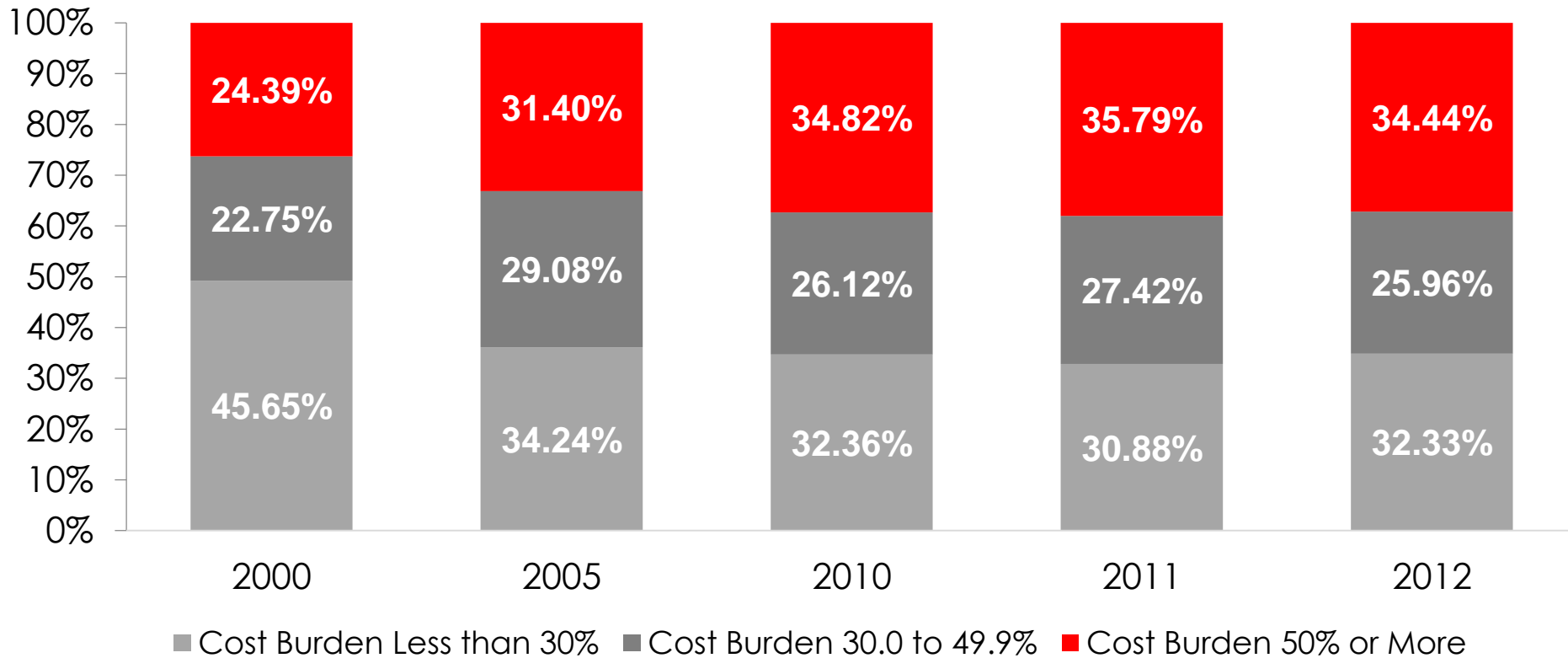

EXTREMELY LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS

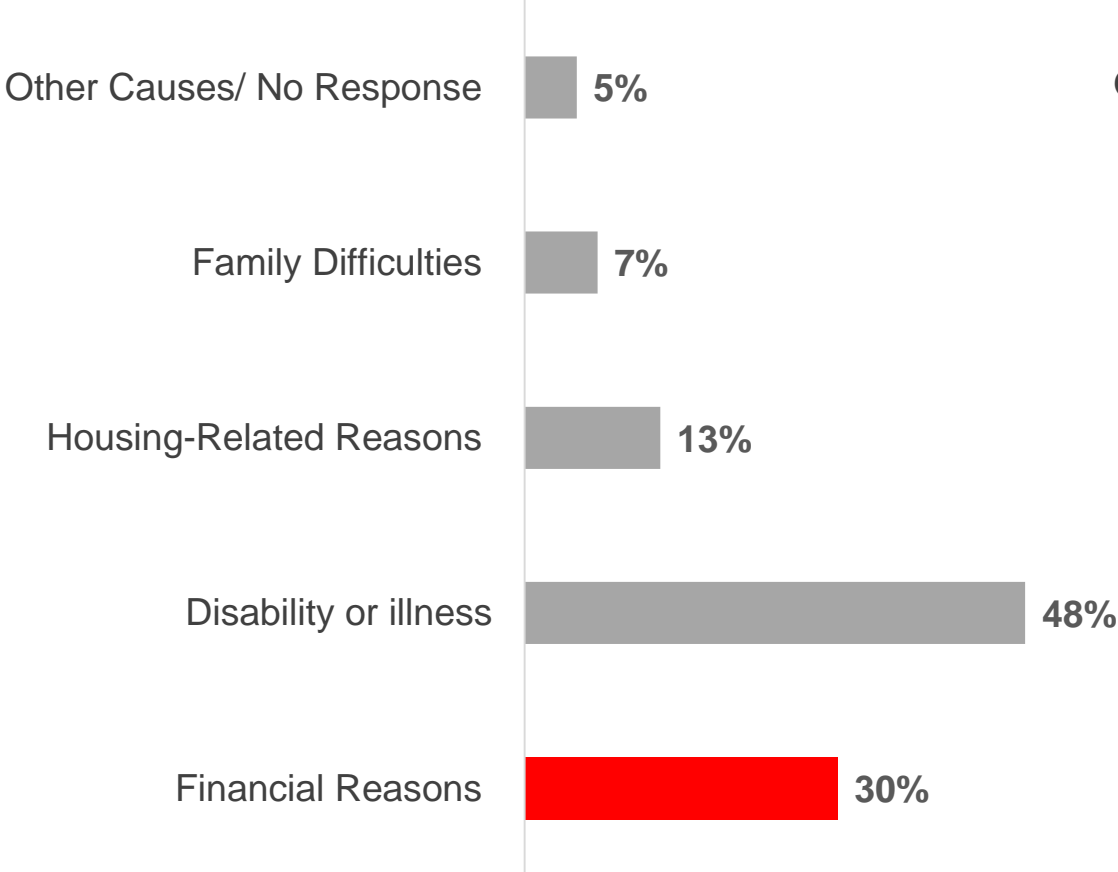
- Extremely low-income (ELI): Households with incomes at or less than **30% AMI**
- **75,000** ELI renter households in Miami-Dade County
- Only **33** units affordable & available per **100** ELI renter households

ESTIMATED % OF COST BURDENED RENTERS

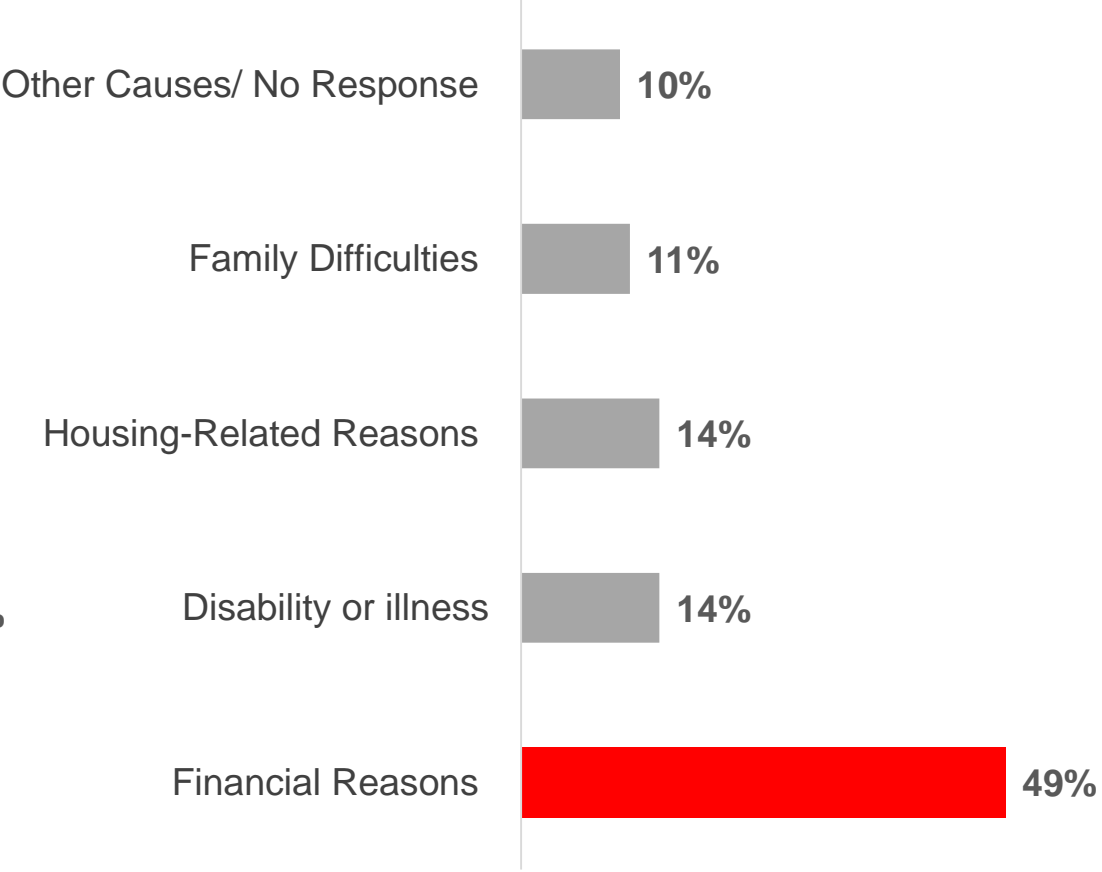


PRIMARY CAUSES OF HOMELESSNESS

Miami-Dade County, 2011

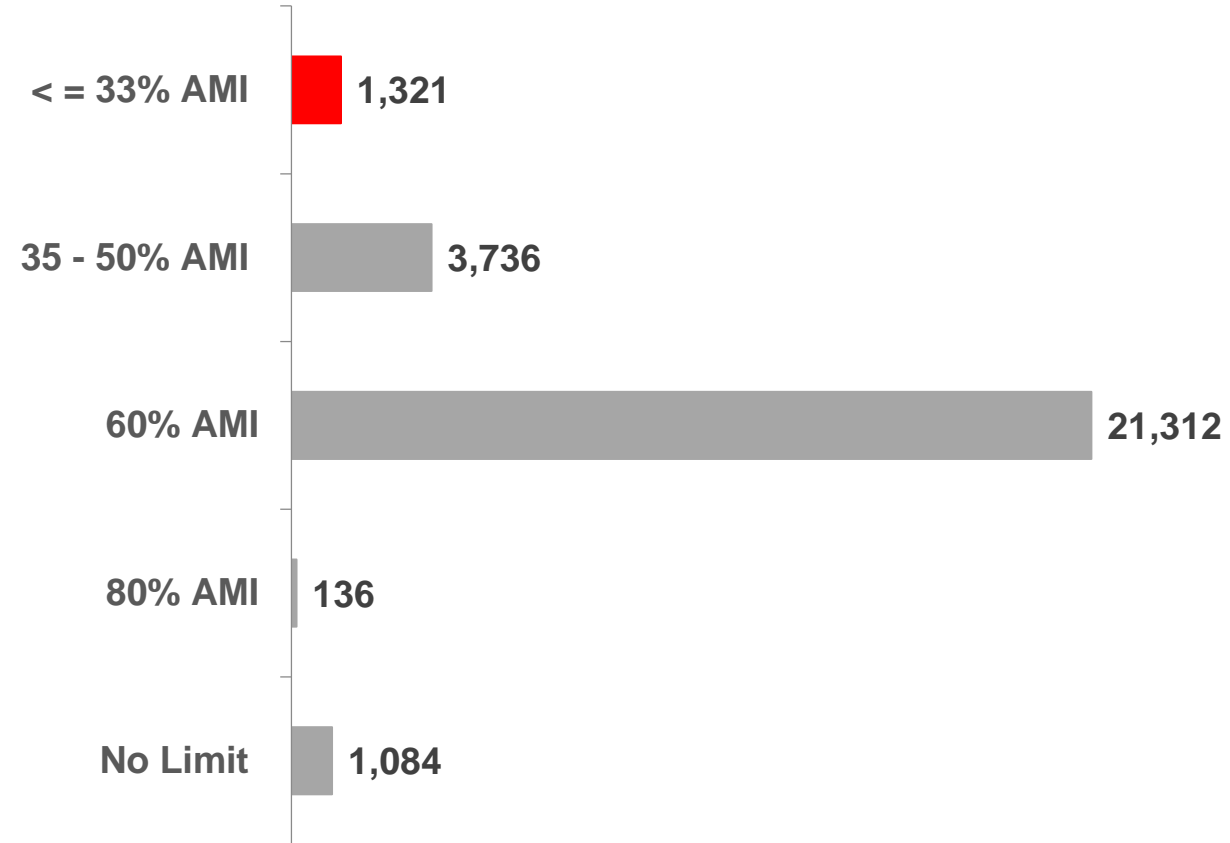


Florida, 2013
